Turning two this September, the store is differentiated from a conventional photo shop in that it does not merely provide photo services and products.


"We value our customers and we are proud that we take the time to consult our clients on their needs when they step in.

The store also houses a studio that can be used for photo shoots. For sale on its shelves are essential photography equipment such as tripods, bags and DSLR video accessories.
